

## ***.22 Black Powder Cartridge Rifle Silhouette Match***

### **Rifles:**

This match while using .22 Rim Fire cartridges is intended to mirror the NRA BPCR Silhouette rules in every aspect. Rifles must be a single shot, external hammer, originally made for black powder cartridges of USA manufacture prior to 1896. Replicas regardless of origin of manufacture, are permitted.

Examples of permitted rifles are 1885 High Wall, Remington Hepburn, or Rolling Block, Low Wall, Sharps, Stevens 44, ref: 3.4 of the NRA BPCR Silhouette Rules for more info.

### **Sights:**

Scopes are permitted that meet the requirements of 3.4.1 of the NRA BPCR Silhouette rules. Mounts are to be of the traditional style of the period, externally adjusted windage and elevation with no clicks. Open sights of the Soule or Malcolm style mounted on the tang are permitted.

### **Targets:**

Chickens at 50 yards, Pigs at 100 yards, Turkeys at 150 yards, and Rams at 200 yards. Targets are scaled to the appropriate size to accommodate the reduced yardages.

### **Time:**

7:30 am to 8:30 am target setup, competitors will need to help with setting targets. Registration and mandatory safety meeting 8:30am to 9:00am, and match starts at 9:00am.

### **Course of fire:**

Format is 40 shots for record, 10 each at chickens, pigs, turkeys and rams. Ten minutes is allotted for each animal with unlimited sighters.

New shooters should contact me prior to match day for additional info. Bring a lunch and water and plan to stay all day.

Please be certain you have sight settings for the match yardages using the ammo you will be shooting in the match.
