

BGTC Members:

In order to address security concerns and to keep trespassers out of the facility, the Board of Directors has retained a security guard service to randomly man a checkpoint located at the fork in the road close to the Range House. When on duty, the guard will be checking everyone's ID card and, in the case of visitors, ensure that the visit is legitimate. Guests should be accompanied to the guard station by the sponsoring member who will vouch for their entry. If a member cannot accompany their guest to the guard station, then the member must provide the guard with the names of all expected guests prior to those guests arriving.

New BGTC ID Cards will soon be issued to every member which will supersede all previous versions of BGTC or Steel City ID cards. Once the new ID cards are issued, that will be the ID Card that members are required to wear/display while on BGTC property and older ID card versions will no longer be honored after that time.

However, until the new ID cards have been distributed, the guard service has been instructed to accept any of the older BGTC or Steel City ID cards for access.

On match days, the guards will be checking all persons entering the property to ensure that they are either members, match participants, or match spectators. As long as the non-member, match participants and spectators know which specific match they are attending, the guard will allow entry. Any other persons will be advised that BGTC is a private facility, not open to the general public, and will be asked to leave the property.
